Guidelines for Conversion of Single Major Programmes to Dual (Two) Major Programmes from the academic year 2025-26

Online Applications are invited from the existing affiliated Private Aided / Un-aided Degree Colleges for conversion of existing Unaided single major programmes of General UG to dual (two) major programmes with effect from 2025-26.

I. Application

Online applications are called from existing Private Unaided and Aided Degree Colleges for conversion of single major programmes to dual (two) major programmes by paying a processing fee of Rs.5,000/- to obtain fresh proceedings for all the programmes to be offered from 2025-26 by logging into www.apsche.org.

II. Schedule

Scrutiny of the proposals	: 01.06.2025 to 14.06.2025
Issuance of Proceedings	: 15.06.2025

II. Guidelines for conversion of existing unaided single majors programmes to dual (two) major programmes

- (1) The existing Unaided single major programmes offered by the Private Unaided and Aided Degree Colleges are to be converted into dual (two) major programmes
- (2) The Degree Colleges can opt to convert each existing single major UG programme to dual (two) major programme with same intake.

For eg: B.Sc Honours (Mathematics) with 50 intake can be converted to:

- (i) B.Sc Honours (Mathematics and Computer Science) with 30 intake and B.A Honours (Economics and Political Science) with 20 intake


(ii) B.Sc Honours (Physics and Computer Science) with 50 intake
or

(iii) B.Sc Honours (Chemistry and Zoology) with 50 intake or

(iv) B.Sc Honours (Food Technology and Chemistry) with 50 intake
or

(v) Any other Dual (Two) Majors Hons programme offered by the University, provided the college has required infrastructure for classroom(s) and labs. In any case, the conversion will only be allowed when adequate infrastructure is available.

- (3) However, in any case of conversion from one single major programme to another dual (two) major programme, there will be no change in intake. And also the total sanctioned intake to the college cannot be increased.
- (4) The conversion can only be made subject to offering of the said programme by the University. The change from Lab to Non-Lab programme is permitted. However, Non-Lab to Lab programme cannot be permitted.
- (5) All dual (two) major programmes will be offered in English Medium in accordance with G.O Ms.No.49 HE(CE) Dept Dt:16.09.2021
- (6) Programmes like B.Com, B.Com (CA), BBA, BCA, B.Voc etc. need not be proposed for conversion. The programmes that are not being proposed for conversion need to be mentioned in the online application form. However, if the Management of the College desires to convert these programme(s) to two major programme(s), they may do so, subject to fulfilment of condition at (2) (v) and 4.
- (7) Regular Degree Colleges are not allowed to convert their programmes into to BHM Honours programmes (Bachelor of Hotel Management) as BHM is to be offered in Colleges of Hotel Management alone.
